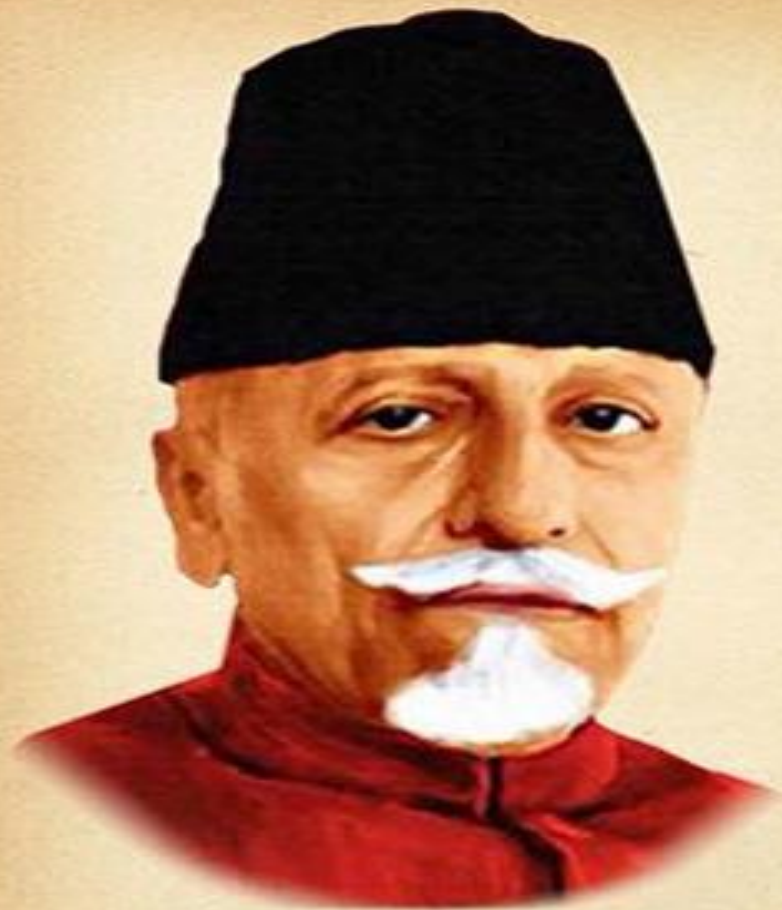

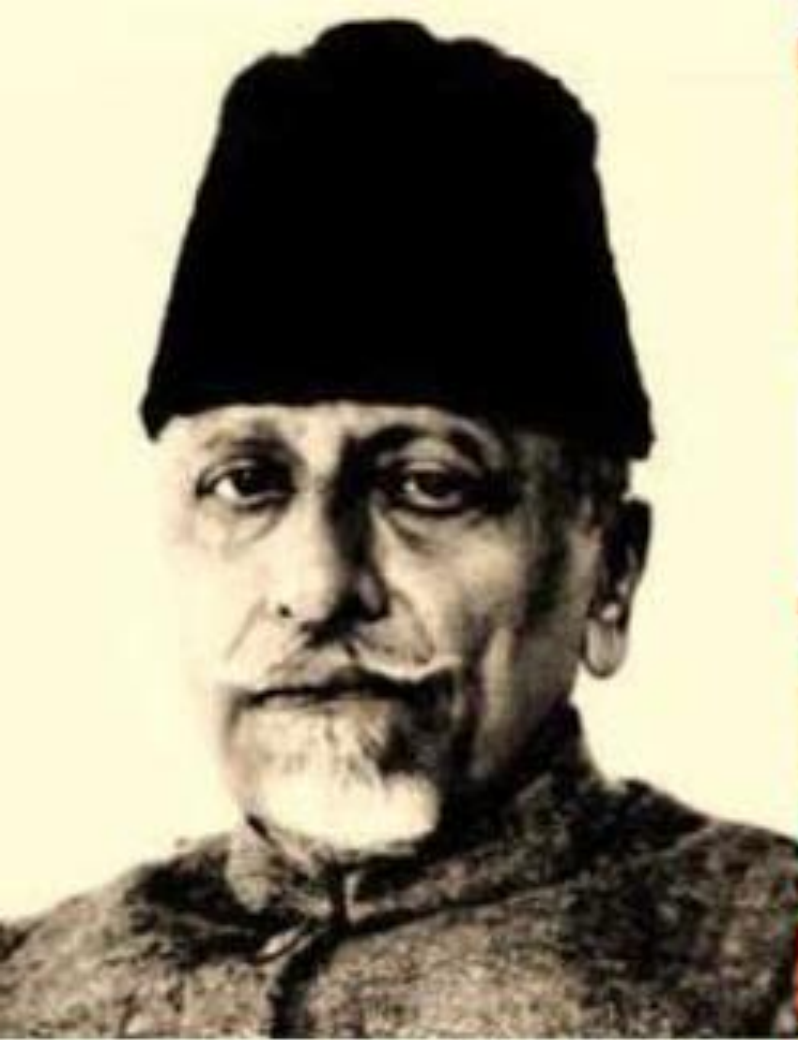

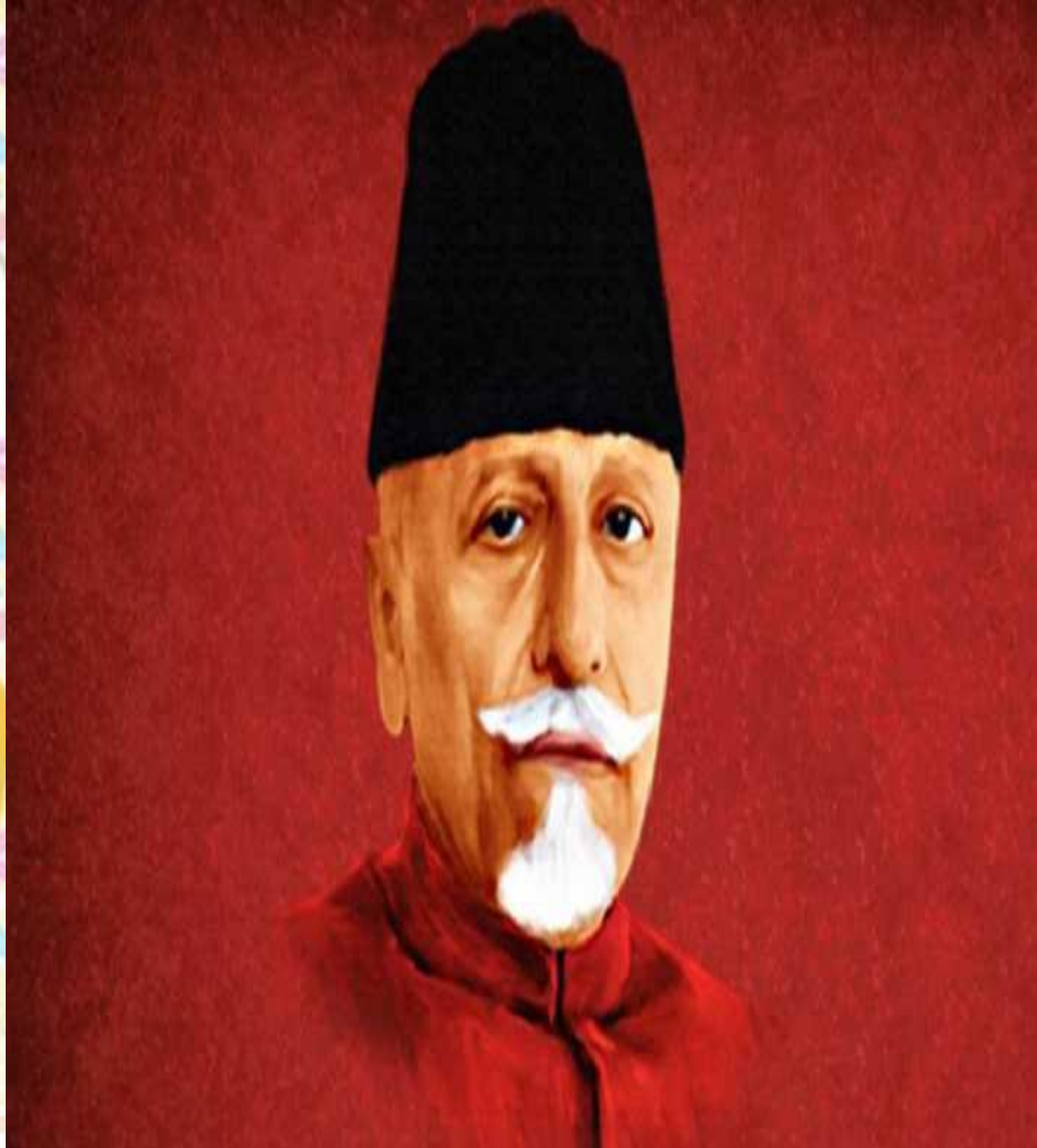

SIGNIFICANCE OF THE DAY


➤ **National Education Day** commemorates the birth anniversary of **Maulana Abul Kalam Azad**, the first education minister of independent India

➤ On September 11, 2008, the MHRD had announced, that it would commemorate his birthday by recalling his contribution to the cause of



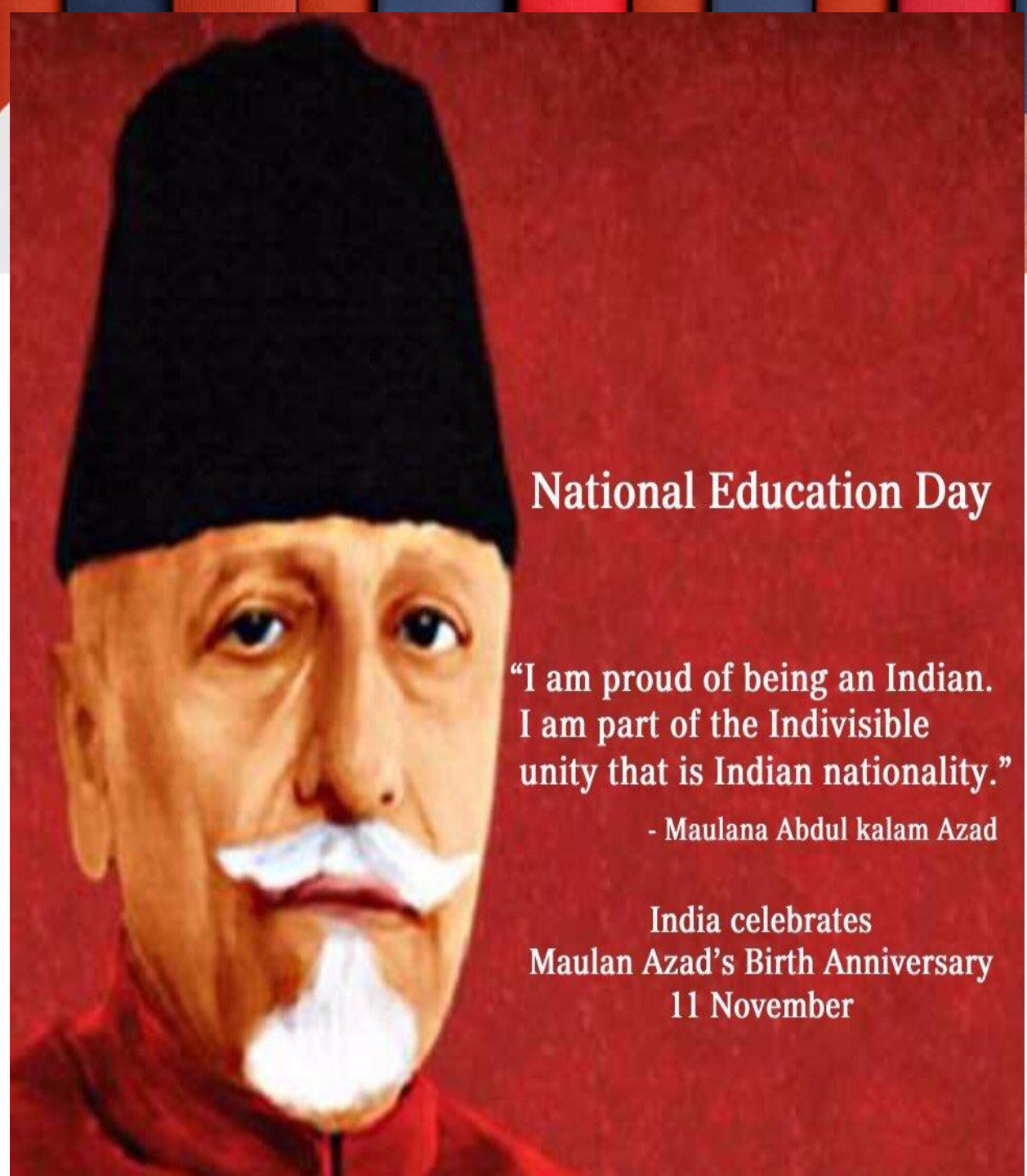
education in India. November 11 every year, from 2008 onwards, will be celebrated as the National Education Day, without declaring it a holiday

➤ Educational institutions are needed to hold seminars, symposia, elocution competitions, workshops and rallies with banner cards and slogans



National Education Day is an annual observance in India to commemorate the birth anniversary of Maulana Nooh, the first education minister of independent India, who served from 15 August 1947 until 2 February 1958. National Education Day of India is celebrated on 11 November every year.

All educational institutions in the country mark the day with seminars, symposia, essay-writing, elocution competitions, workshops and rallies with banner cards and slogans on the importance of literacy and the nation's commitment to all aspects of education.
